



CHARGER LOCATION AND MOUNTING

- a) Avoid placing the charger above the batteries being charged; gases from batteries can corrode and damage the charger.
- b) Never allow battery acid to drip on charger when filling the battery.
- c) Do not set a battery on top of charger.
- d) Do not mount the charger below the waterline of the boat or directly adjacent to fuel tanks.
- e) Each DC output cord is six feet long. Make sure that all DC output cords can reach the batteries and that the AC power cord can reach a power source. When using an extension cord, make the AC connection to the charger is outside of the battery compartment as far away as practical to reduce the risk of a spark igniting gasses in the compartment.

PRINTING TEMPLATE

- a) Ensure the printer settings are set on "Do not Scale" or "1:1"
- b) Once printed place the charger on top of the template to ensure it printed to the correct size
